Weekly Crime Blotter: 10.17.22 - 10.23.22

The weekly crime blotter provides a snapshot of crimes, arrests and other law enforcement activity in the City of Issaquah for the prior week. Data is sourced from official Calls for Service records of the Issaquah Police Department (IPD). The crime blotter compiles incidents deemed noteworthy by IPD and does not include all calls, incidents or self-initiated activities handled by officers. 10/17/22, 0733	2000 BLK Shy Bear Way NW	Reports of area smelling of gasoline. After initial investigation, discovered source was a gas leak from a resident vehicle.	Agency Assist
10/17/22, 1236	70 BLK NW Dogwood St	Catalytic converter was reported stolen between 1800 hrs on 10/15/22 and 0850 hrs of 10/17/22 from a 2000 Toyota 4 Runner.	Theft of Vehicle Parts
10/17/22, 1316	East Lake Sammamish PKWY	A reported hit and run occurred when a vehicle registered in Massachusetts ran another vehicle off the road, scratching the vehicle. No injuries were reported.	Hit and Run

10/18/22, 2058	1400 BLK 10th Way NE	A Hispanic male and Black female were identified grabbing random items off the shelves of a local business around closing time and avoiding employees. Officers arrived on scene and requested subjects return items and escorted them out of the store.	Suspicious

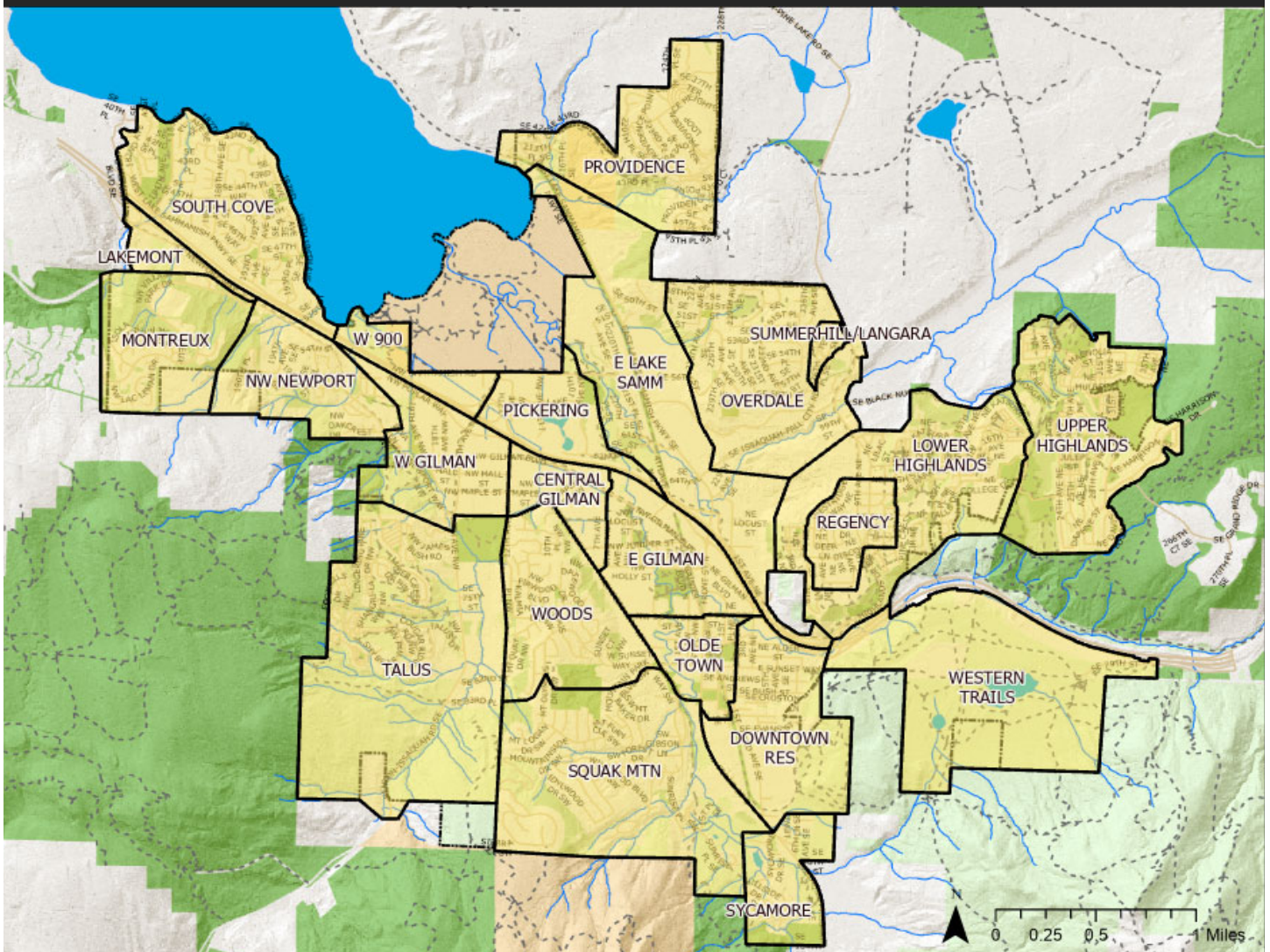


Date, Time	Location	Description	Offense
10/19/22, 1646	700 BLK NW Gilman BLVD	On 10/19/22 at 1646 hrs, officers were advised of a silent alarm from a local bank. A white male wearing maroon scrubs and a black hoodie approached a teller, handing over a note stating they were robbing the location. The suspect fled with stolen property.	Alarm
10/21/22, 0041	Front Street North & I90 East bound	In what appeared to be a possible DUI, on 10/21/22 around 0041 hrs, a small silver sedan with no plates was swerving through lanes on Front Street North at 45 MPH. The vehicle did not yield and proceeded to flee on the I90 freeway east bound out of city limits. Case was transferred to state patrol.	Traffic Stop
10/22/22, 1826	700 BLK NW Gilman BLVD	A white male between 30-40 years of age attempted to steal an undisclosed amount of over the counter medications from a local business. All product was successfully recovered.	Suspicious
10/23/22, 1051	1400 BLK Highlands DR NE	On 10/23/22, a local resident accidentally backed into another car in a parking lot. They reported concern for leaving a note in the rain and decided to wait 30 minutes for the owner of the vehicle to return to exchange information. When the owner did not return, the good Samaritan called our officers to report what had happened. The situation was resolved peacefully.	Citizen Assist
