Weekly Crime Blotter: 10.24.22 - 10.30.22

The weekly crime blotter provides a snapshot of crimes, arrests and other law enforcement activity in the City of Issaquah for the prior week. Data is sourced from official Calls for Service records of the Issaquah Police Department (IPD). The crime blotter compiles incidents deemed noteworthy by IPD and does not include all calls, incidents or self-initiated activities handled by officers. Date, Time	Location	Description	Offense
10/24/22, 0830	400 BLK NE Birch ST	Between 1700 hrs on 10/23/22 and 0830 hrs of 10/24/22, a truck was broken into by unknown means, causing no damage. Various tools and a firearm were stolen from the vehicle. The firearm has been documented and reported as stolen.	Vehicle Prowl
10/24/22, 1223	1400 BLK 10th Way NE	A concerned citizen reported two males distributing what appeared to be drugs out of a wagon and a carry-on luggage around 1930 hrs of the previous day. The first male was of mixed race, roughly 6'3 with short hair while the second male was white, 5'10 with long hair.	Drug Problem

10/24/22, 2051	2000 BLK NW Oakcrest DR	Multiple callers reported hearing 3 shots in the area. Officers responded and spoke with a family who advised they were setting off fireworks for a special celebration. Nobody was hurt or injured. IPD was sadly not invited to the party.	Suspicious
10/25/22, 0206	600 BLK Front Street S	In a case of driving under the influence, at 0206 hrs, a white 4-door sedan crossed lanes, drove over the sidewalk and hit a city sign pole. While airbags were deployed, fortunately neither the driver or the passenger were injured.	Accident / DUI
10/25/22, 0859	23000 BLK SE Black Nugget RD	A driver in a silver SUV fell asleep behind the wheel and hit the sidewalk. The driver was not injured and no property damage was incurred.	Accident
10/25/22, 0929	5000 BLK East Lake Sammamish PKWY	On 10/25/22 at 0929 hrs, a call came in reporting a one yr old child accidentally locked in a vehicle. The child was playing with the keys and inadvertently locked the vehicle doors. Officers were able to open the doors and safely reunite the child and mother.	Citizen Assist

The reporting party was standing in a parking stall when another person drove by yelling threatening comments to the person while referencing their suspected ethnicity. 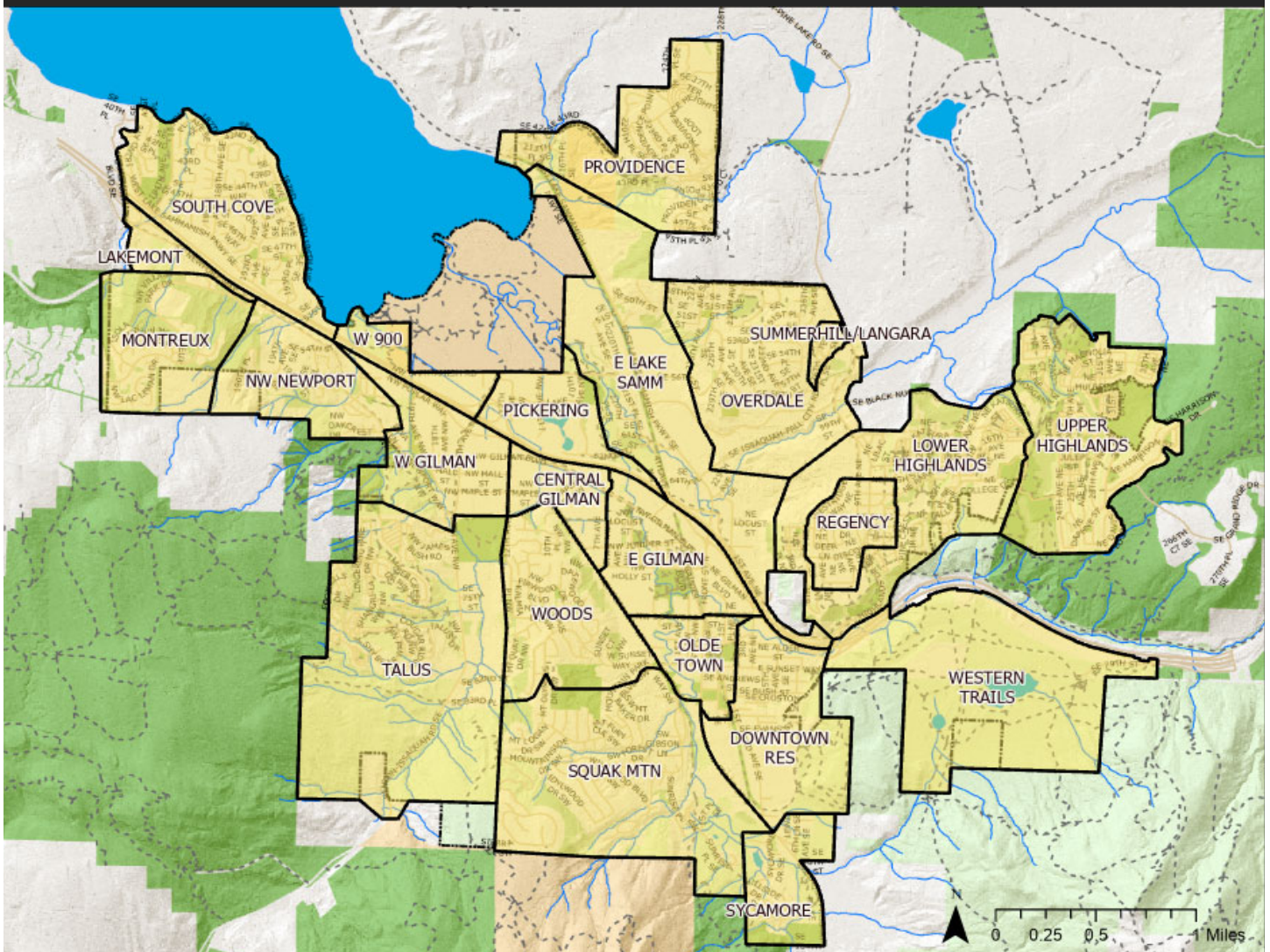


Date, Time	Location	Description	Offense
10/28/22, 2229	18000 BLK SE Newport Way	At 2229 hrs, 3 vehicles, including a gray Nissan sedan and another gray sedan, were seen speeding through a complex. Vehicles reportedly nearly hit a dog and another vehicle in the parking lot. Officers responded to scene but suspects were gone on arrival.	Reckless Driving
10/29/22, 1412	6000 BLK East Lake Sammamish PKWY	On 10/29/22 around 1412 hrs, a concerned citizen reported a potential hot wiring of a vehicle in a parking lot. Upon responding, officers spoke to the individuals who turned out to be a locksmith and car owner who had valid proof of ownership.	Suspicious
10/29/22, 1952	1000 BLK 17th Ave NW	On 10/29/22, IPD received a report of a subject on location possibly having hallucinations. Upon responding, officers discovered the individual was hungry, had tried to walk in front of moving vehicles to hurt themselves and had recently taken an undisclosed amount of substance with the intent of harming themselves. The individual was taken to receive care and a meal.	Agency Assist
