Weekly Crime Blotter: 01.02.23 - 01.08.23

The weekly crime blotter provides a snapshot of crimes, arrests and other law enforcement activity in the City of Issaquah for the prior week. Data is sourced from official Calls for Service records of the Issaquah Police Department (IPD). The crime blotter compiles incidents deemed noteworthy by IPD and does not include all calls, incidents or self-initiated activities handled by officers. 01/02/23, 0043	NW Steeltake PL & Skyfield LN NW	On 01/02/23, a concerned citizen called in reporting a male in all black clothing potentially casing vehicles. Responding officers were able to make contact with the suspect who turned out to have a felony warrant. Officers transported the suspect to Seattle.	Vehicle Prowl In-Progress
01/02/23, 1353	700 BLK NW Gilman BLVD	At approximately 1353 hrs, a report came in stating a white male in their 50's, bald, wearing a blue jacket and jeans, had a large knife sticking out of their back pocket. They were last seen on a trail, walking towards the Post Office. Responding officers searched but were unable to locate the suspect.	Suspicious

01/03/23, 1421	900 BLK NW Gilman BLVD	On 01/03/23, a local resident called to report two children under the age of 5 in a vehicle with a white male passed out in the back seat. Officers arrived to discover the male was the father and had fallen asleep while waiting for his wife to return from shopping.	None.
01/03/23, 1527	28th AVE NE & NE Julep ST	A black SUV was noted to have been left on location over the course of four days. Officers responded on 01/03/23 and observed the driver side tires were slashed. After contacting the owner, they decided to work on arranging a tow service.	Abandoned Vehicle
01/03/23, 1623	6000 BLK East Lake Sammamish PKWY	Around 1607 hrs, a Hispanic male subject was seen entering a local business with an empty shopping cart and was caught on camera exiting the store with unpaid merchandise. An employee was able to get photos of the suspect and the vehicle he was associated with, which led to the successful identification and citation of the individual.	Theft

After leaving, the subject left a suitcase and bloody gauze on the front step, as well as possible graffiti. Responding officers searched but were unable to locate the subject. Responding officers were unable to locate the subject but were able to successfully recover the shopping cart of stolen goods. All merchandise was returned to the local business.	Theft In-Progress

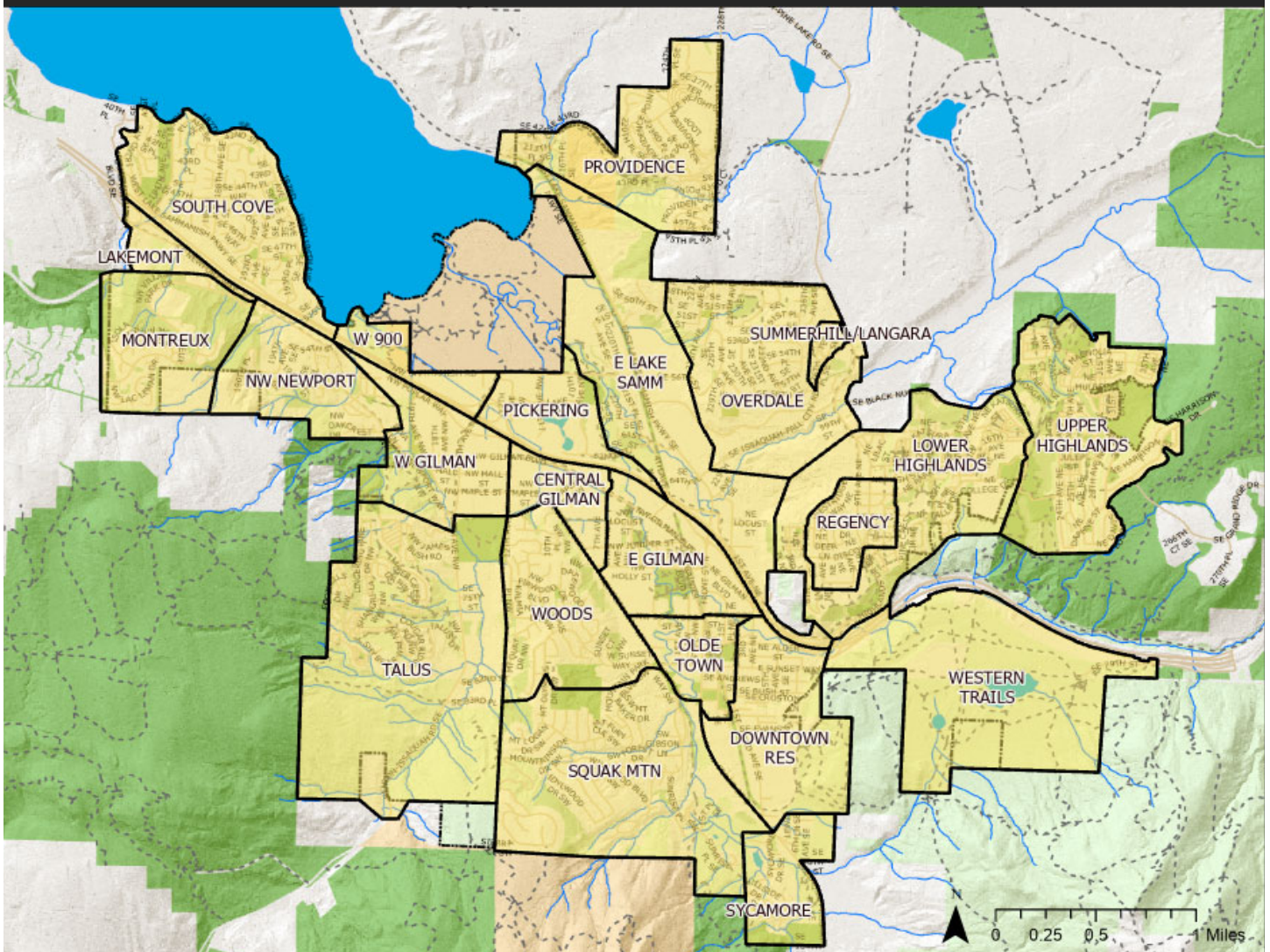


Date, Time	Location	Description	Offense
01/06/23, 1959	700 BLK NW Gilman BLVD	On 01/06/23, an employee of a local business reported an extremely intoxicated male urinating in the business. Officers trespassed the individual for three years from the location while the man's friends took him home.	Suspicious
01/06/23, 2112	900 BLK NE High ST	Around 212 hrs, a group of juveniles were found street racing on a local business' property. Officers arrived to trespass the individuals and gave verbal warnings to each.	Suspicious
01/07/23, 1909	Shy Bear Way NW & NW Talus DR	A report came in around 1909 hrs stating there were loud popping noises in the community over the last 30 minutes. Officers searched for the source but were unable to locate the source of the sounds.	Noise Complaint
