

## New Single-Family Fee Schedule

Below you will find the most common fees associated with new single family construction. This is to be used as a guide only and fees may change based on the scope of your project. This schedule is based on a new single family house being constructed on a vacant lot in the City of Issaquah's water service area. If the lot is located in another water district or the lot is not vacant, different fees will apply. Review your plat requirements for any additional charges. At time of permit application, all plan review deposit is required. The deposit will be credited toward your *Plan Review Fee* at time of permit approval. All fees listed are per house.

Fee	How It's Calculated
<b>Building Permit Fee</b>	Based on <a href="#">Project Valuation Chart</a>
<b>Plan Review Fee</b>	65% of <i>Building Permit Fee</i> OR 97.5% of <i>Building Permit Fee</i> if expedited consultant review is requested Additional hourly fees may apply
<b>Land Development Review</b>	\$2,500
<b>Mechanical Permit Fee</b>	8% of <i>Building Permit Fee</i>
<b>Plumbing Permit Fee</b>	8% of <i>Building Permit Fee</i>
<b>Technology Surcharge</b>	5% of everything above this line
<b>State Surcharge</b>	\$6.50 (add \$2 for each additional dwelling unit if more than 1)

## King County Sewer Capacity Charge

Every new sewer connection will be assessed a Sewer Capacity Charge by King County. The total cost is based on the date of the sewer connection. This fee is administered by King County and is not included in any of the fees listed on page 1 of this document.

Fire Sprinkler	See <a href="#">Fire Permit Fee Schedule</a>
Electrical Permit(s)	These are issued and inspected by <a href="#">Washington State LNI</a>
