LOCAL ACCESS

There may be up to a 10-minute delay where driveway access is limited as the treatment is being performed.

The road during this phase of work may be driven on minutes after it is placed. The hours of operation are from 7 a.m.- 4 p.m.

PARKING.

Please respect the “No Parking” signs. The dates written on these signs will have the most current information for the project. If you have any questions or concerns with the signs, please contact the inspector via the contact information below.

TOWING

Vehicles located within the “No Parking” zones that impact the planned work will be subject to towing. Please remove all vehicles from the affected areas prior to 7am each working day.

We will make every attempt to contact the vehicle owner prior to towing.

PLAN AHEAD

Beginning August 25

The Overdale neighborhood has been selected by the Pavement Management Program (PMP) to receive a maintenance treatment known as a Cape Seal. This treatment includes two separate phases of work before the Cape Seal is complete, and intermittent sweeping operations will occur between phases. This notice addresses the first phase, and you will receive an additional notice with specifics on the second phase in a few weeks.

On August 25 and 26, the contractor will place a thin layer of new, small rocks over a fresh coat of asphalt emulsion (oil). This work will extend through the full width of the roadway. The loose rock will be swept thoroughly the following day, and again the following Monday.

Please note that this is only the first phase of the project, and the next phase will leave the surface with a smooth texture and uniform black appearance. We appreciate your patience and cooperation as we help to improve your neighborhood roadways.

- ✓ Sharp turning movements and fast breaking may damage the roadway until the final treatment is placed.
