Example: If your family size is 2 and your household income is \$31,050 or less, you are eligible for a 90% Scholarship

HOUSEHOLD SIZE includes all persons who live in your home and share living expenses.

Scholarship discount is based on annual household income per above chart.

PURPOSE

The purpose of the Recreation Scholarship Program is to allow for discounted recreation program fees so that low-income families and individuals may have equitable access to City of Issaquah recreation programs.

ELIGIBILITY

Youth and Adults who reside **within the city limits of Issaquah** and whose families meet the income eligibility criteria.

Children and Youth (under the age 18) whose households reside **within the Issaquah School District boundary** and whose families meet the income eligibility criteria.

Approved applicants will be eligible for discounts totaling a maximum of \$450 per family member, per calendar year. Eligible applicants will be **required to provide proof of residence and income for entire household**. Household is defined as: all individuals living in your home. For example: mother, father, aunt, uncle, grandparents etc.

Submit only **copies** of your documents and **attach them to the completed application**. Copies **will not be returned or retained**. Return completed forms and documents to the Issaquah Community Center Front Desk or by email: scholarships@issaquahwa.gov

- **2022** Income verification for ALL income earners in the household (**REQUIRED**)
Please submit one of the following:
 - o Tax return
 - o W-2(s)
- **2022** Proof of Residency (**REQUIRED**)
Supporting documents must have the name and address of service location on them.
Please submit one of the following:
 - o Water, sewer, garbage bills
 - o PSE gas/electric bill
 - o Lease agreement or Mortgage paperwork
- **2022** Qualification or Participation in one of the following programs (**REQUIRED, IF APPLICABLE**)
 - o DSHS Services Approval letter for applicant
 - o Applicant is a Foster Child
 - o Preschool age child participating in the Head Start Program

Scholarship applications must be approved prior to registration

A scholarship application alone does not register the participant, nor does it reserve space in a program. Registrations are processed in the order received. You will be notified once your application for scholarship has been reviewed.

Exclusions

Scholarships are not applicable for: birthday parties, adult leagues, and or private sessions. Some other exclusions may apply.
