

# Site Work and Utility Permit Fee Schedule

Below you will find the permit fee schedule for site work and utilities. Contact Development Services if you have any questions regarding what fees apply to your project.

## Site Work Permit Fees

**Consultant Reviews.** In addition to the fees imposed pursuant to the fee schedule contained in this chapter, the applicant for the permits set forth in the City's land use fee schedule shall reimburse the City for the costs of professional consultants hired by the City to process and/or review and inspect the applicant's proposal, when the City is unable to do so with existing in-house staff. These professional services may include, but shall not be limited to, engineering, traffic engineering, legal, financial and accounting, soils, landscaping, and critical areas. The City may require the applicant to deposit an amount with the City to cover anticipated costs of retaining professional consultants; provided, that the Mayor has approved retaining the professional consultants.

**Additional Review.** The fees identified in this schedule are based on expected staff costs to cover 3 plan reviews and the required inspections. For permit reviews where applicants require more than 3 reviews, the City shall charge an additional 30 percent of the initial permit fee for each review beyond the third review. This added fee is intended to cover the additional time required for staff to review resubmittals.

  - 4 Any permit applicant may appeal to the Director for reduction (partial refund) in any fees paid. Any request must provide permit number; full contact information; and, rationale for why the particular fee should be reduced.
  - 5 Fees for residential projects are based on total number of new units contained within the permitted project development area of the permit
  - 6 SF: refers to the gross square footage of a building or buildings on the property
  - 7 Engineering fees shall be paid as follows: 50% due at application and remaining amount due at permit issuance
  - 9 Paid in lieu of standard plan review fee
  - 10 Paid in lieu of standard permit fee
